

ACADEMIC SUCCESS AT BAYFIELD HIGH SCHOOL



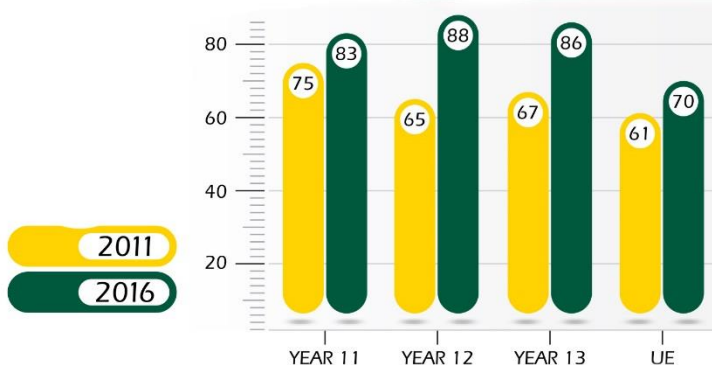
